Reservation conditions EUROCAMP UK Basketball Camp 2024

1.REGISTRATION FORM

Boys and girls aged 12 to 17 can enroll in the program. To complete the reservation, you must fill in the online registration form and send it together with the receipt of the first payment. Passport must be presented to enter England.

Reservation of the place for the trip to England will be considered effective when the registration form and proof of the first payment have been received.

Places are limited (a very small group of players travel) and will be awarded on a first-come. First-served basis.

2. PAYMENT TERMS:

Registration for the two basketball campuses in England is priced at 2980 euros.

A payment and deposit of 700 euros required at the time of booking.

All other payments will be made in two installments:

April 1st, payment of 1000 euros.

June 1st, payment of 1280 euros.

Families will be sent an email to remind them of the dates for the second and third payments.

Registrations that have not been settled within the agreed deadlines will not be considered formalized and will transfer the spot to another Player on the waiting list, losing the amount of the deposit. Failure to make the entry in the agreed data will mean the cancellation of the reservation.

3. PRICES

The price of the trip includes ALL SERVICES

- Departure and Return journey by plane
- -Transfer between the airport and the destination
- -Accommodation and full board every day.
- -Registration on the 2 Eurocamp campuses
- -Visit to London, travel, guided tour, tickets (Thames Cruise, London Eye), activities and lunch.
- -Support of a Sunrise monitor from the departure of the airport and throughout the stay and the return.
- -Multi-travel Insurance

- -Laundry
- -IVA
- -Material: backpack, hooded sweatshirt, game shirt, technical shirt and cotton shirt.

4. FLIGHT INFORMATION:

You will receive the exact information about the departure flights and the time of arrival at the airports as well as the meeting point by e-mail about 10 days before the departure in anticipation of possible changes or alterations in the Flight hours.

5. CANCELLATION EXPENSES

Cancellation of the campus booking in England will result in the forfeiture of the first installment.

If the cancellation occurs before May 15th, 50% of the two payments made will be refunded.

If the cancellation occurs after May 15th, 75% of the two payments paid by the program will be lost.

If the cancellation occurs after 15 days before the camp starts, no refund will be refunded.

In case one player doesn't bring the passport, quits the camp, or doesn't show up in the airport no money will be refunded.

SUNRISE has an insurance that covers the flights in case the player can't assist in the program because of illness or injury.

6. INSURANCE

The price includes compulsory travel Insurance for all players, which includes:

- -Medical assistance
- -Civil Liability

Document that we can send if you wish.

7. DOCUMENTATION PLAYER:

The Player must have the original passport in force on the day of departure.

The Player must have a European Health Insurance Card and take it to the airport.

8. MEETING INFORMATION

The director of Sunrise will contact the family and organize a Meeting to get to know you personally, to resolve any doubts and to be able to clarify any issues about the campuses where your children go and give you all the material (backpack, sweatshirt, shirts...) that the players will have to take to England.

In case the meeting is online, the material will be sent home.

9. MATERIAL TIPS

Here's a general idea to help you pack:

- -Training clothes T-shirts and play pants.
- -Abundant play socks.
- -Basketball shoes and street shoes
- -Underwear, socks and pijama.
- -Short and long pants.
- -Street T-shirts.
- -Sweatshirts and long sleeve jacket.
- -Bath towel/ hand towel
- -Toiletry with bath gel, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, and hairbrush.

The campuses have a laundry service and one day at the end of each campus they will wash their clothes. The monitor will accompany the campers and tell them where to wash their clothes. SUNRISE will pay for the service.

You can bring a 25 kg suitcase that you will check in and a backpack that you can take with you as a handover.

Remember that plugs in England are different here and you'll have to go to a power Store to buy a suitable adapter to plug in your cell phone or any other device.

Remember to Exchange euros for pounds before traveling. The pound is the current currency in the UK.

As for the Pocket-Money, think that all expenses are included, travel, visits, lunches, dinners, laundry... We think that about 150 pounds will be enough for personal expenses: drinks, ice-cream, souvenirs...

9. BEHAVIOUR RULES

The Player who travels to England and participates in the EUROCAMP campuses, agrees to:

- -Comply the rules requires for coexistence on the different campuses and in the excursions and outings that are organized during the stay in England.
- -Maintain respectful relationship with all teammates, coaches, and monitors.
- -Accept the authority, suggestions, and recommendations of the people in charge of the program: tutor, coaches, canteen staff... in order to facilitate their smooth running.

10.REASON FOR EXPULSION FROM CAMPUS

Non-compliance with the following rules:

- -Tobacco or alcohol consumption
- -Absence of the Player in training
- -Any exclusionary and/or aggressive manifestation towards teammates, coaches or the environment.
- -Failure to follow the instructions of the coaches/monitors
- -Damage to the facilities or equipment of the center, as well as any damage outside the facilities.
- -Thefts inside the center or at any of the scheduled outings. If a camper is arrested for the theft by local Police, he will be handed over to local justice and repatriated to his home once released.

Expenses arising from expulsion from campus will be borne by the participant's relatives.

11. AUDIOVISUAL MATERIAL

Parents grant permission to use any photographic or audiovisual material in which the participant appears to be posted on the SUNRISE website.

The data of the participant will be confidential and will be used only by the Organization of the program in accordance with the current legislation on the protection of personal data.

SUNRISE Organization is not responsible for the content about the campus that the players may post on their social networks.

12. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS

Participation in the Sunrise trip to England implies acceptance by the Player of each one of the general conditions detailed above.
